

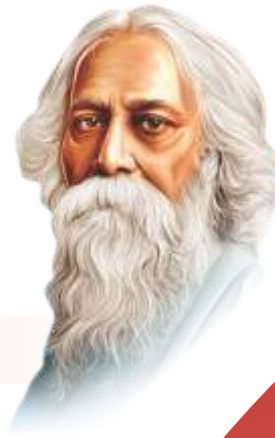

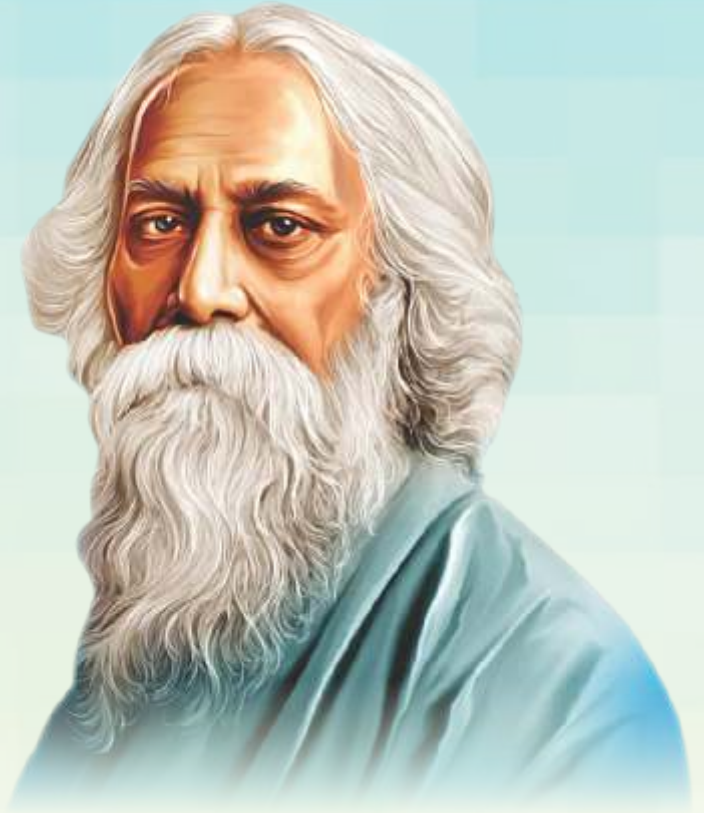

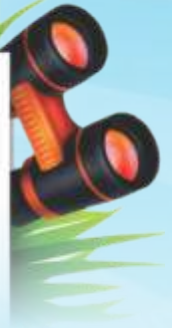

House System

All the students are divided into four houses. The house system forms the base of all competitions. Through these competitions we teach them that winning is not the most important, but participation is. This also develops a sense of belonging and house spirit among the students

Children are divided among four houses –

1. Bhagat House
2. Kalpana House
3. Sarojini House
4. Subhash House

Names of the houses have been selected that the students emulate qualities innate among these leaders.

Each house conducts morning assembly in rotation and inter house competitions like *poem-recitation, calligraphy, dance (solo+group) Hindi and English speech competitions, Debates, Rakhi and Diya making* are held. Winner house is awarded trophy at the end of the session.



School Uniform

Any violation will be taken as indiscipline and the child may be turned out of the school for the day or fined a penalty of Rs. 50/- for such violation. A repeated violation will be considered wilful disobedience and the child may be rusticated/expelled from the school.

Admission

Admission - **Nursery to IX and XI**
Starts on : **Last Sunday of February**
Last admission date : **last Sunday of March.**

- ◆ You can get your child registered right now.
- ◆ Academic session begins on 01st April and ends on 31st March of the ensuing year
- ◆ **Age consideration** : Refer NEP 2020 or as per the directions of CBSE/ Education department of Haryana
- ◆ **Teaching faculty** : We explore various means for selection of committed and meritorious teachers who could belong to any land and region.

- ◆ **Curriculum** : We prepare our school curriculum for all the classes taking cues from CBSE curriculum. Teachers follow it since it's a guiding factor for them "**What to teach**"
- ◆ **Pedagogy** : Pedagogy is an answer to "**How to Teach**" the curriculum that has been designed by the subject experts. It also tells why to teach in a particular way.
- ◆ **Academic Calendar** : It's a schedule of all the events and activities during an academic year. Academic calendar is prepared before the academic session starts and there could be some amendments or variations as per the needs.



Registration

The application form for admission, detachable from the school prospectus, to be deposited in the office along with the registration

fee. A registration number with the date of admission test will be allotted at the time of submission of admission form.

Documents Required for Admission

- ◆ The school leaving certificate/Transfer certificate signed by the Head of the Institution last attended and countersigned by the competent authority
- ◆ Report Card/DMC of the previous class.
- ◆ Date of birth certificate issued by the Registrar of births.
- ◆ 3 copies of the PP size photograph of the student.
- ◆ Migration certificate from Board in case class X was passed from a Board other than CBSE.
- ◆ Caste certificate if belongs to reserved category
- ◆ Copy of Aadhar Card.
- ◆ The parents are to sign an undertaking that their ward is free from any contagious disease.

Code of conduct for students

Any student found guilty of a serious breach of discipline will be summarily expelled from the school without any liability on the part of the institution.

In case of any legal involvement with the school, either by the student or by his/her parent/guardian, to safeguard the interests of other students and to maintain a healthy atmosphere in the school, the school authorities reserve the right to cancel the admission of the concerned student without any prior notice and the entire fee paid during the academic year shall be forfeited and even the entry of the child/parents will be restricted.

The following shall constitute the breach of school discipline:

- ◆ Misconduct and moral turpitude.
- ◆ Non-payment of school dues.
- ◆ Non-adherence to school rules and regulations.
- ◆ Continuous absence for a fortnight without proper sanction of leave.
- ◆ Damage to the school property.
- ◆ Use of foul or abusive language.

Attendance

- ◆ We encourage punctuality and regularity. A child with 100% attendance is given a citation on Annual Result Declaration Day.
- ◆ If a child remains absent from school without a proper sanction of leave, he will be fined Rs. 10/-per day.
- ◆ *A continuous absence of 15 days or irregularity will get the name struck off the school rolls.*
- ◆ No leave will be sanctioned during examination.

School Dues

School tuition fee is to be paid on quarterly basis before 15th of every first month of the set. Defaults in payment will be treated as follows :

Defaults of dates	:	Pecuniary Penalty/Late fee fine
1 to 15 of the First month of the quarter	:	No late fee fine
16 to 20 of the first month of the quarter	:	Rs.5/- per day
21 to 25 of the first month of the quarter	:	Rs. 10/- per day
26 to the last day of the First month of the quarter	:	Rs. 20/- per day

If the dues are not received till the last day of the First month, the name of child will automatically get struck off.

Withdrawals

When a child is admitted in the school, parents who desire to withdraw him/her are required to submit in writing at least one month in advance. After the application is received the child will be issued with a school TC on clearance of various dues of different faculties including the school dues. Security money once claimed in writing will further be sent to the parents by A/C Payee cheque in the name of the child after 30 days of the issuance of TC and after all the dues have been settled. If the security money is not claimed within six months of the withdrawal/striking off the name, it will automatically get forfeited.

Re-admission

When the name of the student is struck off the rolls for any reason, whatsoever, the parents will have to seek re-admission if they are interested in it.

Criteria to Decide the Distinction

- Academic** : 85% and above score in aggregate at the Annual Examination PURPLE
- Cultural & Sports** : State representation in any of the fields, NAVY BLUE
(Sports colour holders will have a special symbol just above the school crest on their pockets.)

There is a Hostel facility provided to all desirous students.

Visits to different places, corporate sectors, industries and entertainment events are organised on regular basis.



RO System :

School maintains a complete certified RO system to provide purified water supply to the students and other staff.

School Colours & Distinctions

In order to distinguish and create exalted feeling, the distinction holders of various fields are awarded colours to be worn on their pockets. During winter they put on distinguishable blazers. These distinctions are created in Academic, Sports & Cultural fields and are applicable from class VI onwards.



Standby Source of Supply :

- ◆ All 24 hrs uninterrupted standby source of electricity.
- ◆ Safety and security manned by supporting staff and CCTVs



General Rules and Regulations of The School

- ◆ Punctuality and regularity in attendance is essential. In case of illness a Medical Certificate should also be sent.
- ◆ A minimum of 75% attendance is compulsory to be eligible to appear in the examination.
- ◆ Students must come to school in neatly laundered uniform and polished shoes. The hair should be trimmed and the nails must be cut regularly. Girls with long hair should make plaits.
- ◆ Respect for school property and school belongings is an absolute must.
- ◆ In the event of collective damage to school property in class room, the entire class will be charged the cost of damage. A vigilant outlook should be maintained towards keeping the surroundings clean.
- ◆ All students are expected to greet their school teachers when they meet them whether they actually teach them or not
- ◆ No books (other than text books or library books), magazines CDs, Pen Drives etc should be brought to school. If they are brought, they will be confiscated
- ◆ Lending or borrowing of money or other articles is not allowed
- ◆ Students should not spoil or pluck flowers
- ◆ Students using unfair means during examination will face disciplinary action
- ◆ Bullying, use of abusive and foul language, rowdy or violent behaviour in any form are punishable offences
- ◆ Students are not allowed to leave the class without class out-pass and without permission of the teacher. While moving in between the classes in the corridors and while using the staircases all must keep to the left. Students should move in a way that no child is disturbed.
- ◆ A student must speak in decent language all the time. He/She must ensure that his speech is courteous and polite.
- ◆ Every student is required to carry the school identity card each day of the school.
